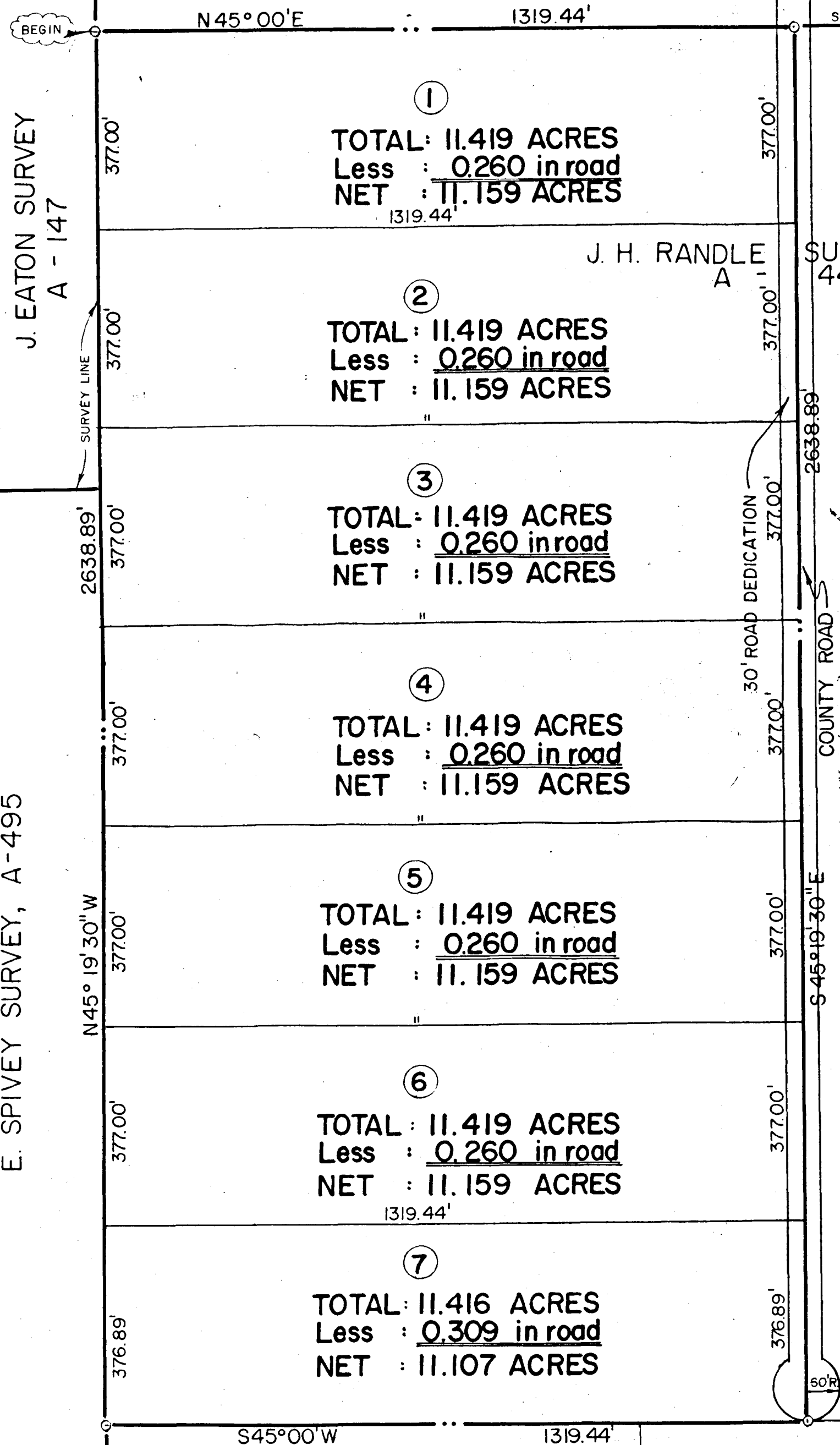

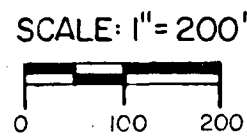
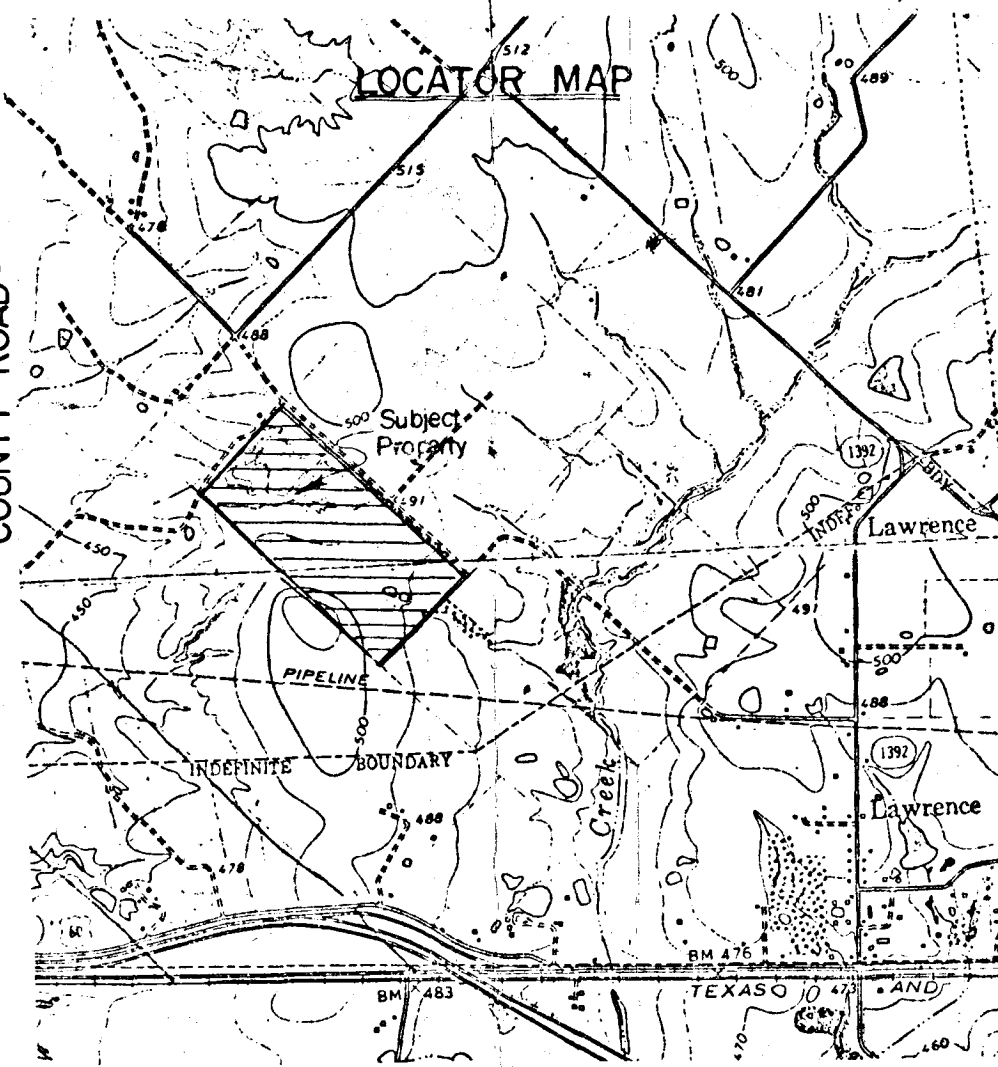

BEING all that tract of land in Kaufman County, Texas, a part of the J. H. Randle Survey, A-442 and being all that tract of land conveyed to Twovest Properties from Brenda J. Marshall as Attorney-in-Fact for O. W. Brown on July 19, 1984 and recorded in Volume 777, Page 63, Kaufman County Deed Records, and being further described as follows:

BEGINNING at the West corner of said tract, a $\frac{1}{2}$ " steel rod set for corner;
THENCE North 45 degrees 00 minutes East, 1319.44 feet to the North corner of said tract, said point being in a dirt road, a $\frac{1}{2}$ " steel rod bears South 45 degrees 00 minutes West, 15.00 feet for witness;
THENCE South 45 degrees 19 minutes 30 seconds East, 2638.89 feet to the East corner of said tract, said point being in a dirt road, a $\frac{1}{2}$ " steel rod bears South 45 degrees 00 minutes West, 15.00 feet for witness;
THENCE South 45 degrees 00 minutes West, 1319.44 feet to the South corner of said tract, a $\frac{1}{2}$ " steel rod found for corner;
THENCE North 45 degrees 19 minutes 30 seconds West, 2638.89 feet along the Southwest line of said tract to the point of beginning, containing 79.930 acres of land, of which 0.909 acres lie within said dirt road, leaving a net of 79.021 acres.

The plat and description as shown hereon are a true and accurate representation, to the best of my knowledge and belief, of the property as determined by an on-the-ground survey performed under my supervision during the month of October, 1984.
