

RESOLUTION NO. 2061

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRELL,
TEXAS, CANCELLING THE MAY 6, 2023, GENERAL ELECTION FOR
THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING COUNCIL MEMBER FOR DISTRICT NO.
3 FOR THE CITY OF TERRELL, TEXAS, AND DECLARING THE
UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE FOR COUNCIL MEMBER FOR DISTRICT
NO. 3 ELECTED TO OFFICE**

WHEREAS, the City of Terrell, Texas, is a home rule municipality located in Kaufman County, Texas, and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with law a General Election has been ordered for May 6, 2023, for the purpose of electing a Councilmember for Council District No. 3 for the City of Terrell, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has certified in writing that the candidate on the ballot is unopposed for election to office; and

WHEREAS, the filing deadlines for placement on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy has passed; and

WHEREAS, in these circumstances, Subchapter C of Chapter 2 of the Texas Election Code authorizes a governing body to declare an unopposed candidate elected to office and cancel the election.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
TERRELL, TEXAS THAT:**

SECTION 1. The following candidate, who is unopposed in the May 6, 2023, General Election, is hereby declared elected to office and shall be issued a certificate of election:

Council Member District No. 3

SECTION 2. The City Secretary is directed to post a copy of this Resolution at each designated polling place on or before May 6, 2023.
